ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S POWER UNIT SEGMENT RECEIVES DEVELOPMENT ORDER FROM U.S. MARINE CORPS.

Hauppauge, New York, December 10, 2002—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Unit Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc., has received a development order for \$100,000 from the United States Marine Corps for a portable frequency converter intended for use in harsh battlefield conditions.

The initial order is for four qualification units with expected delivery in the second quarter of 2003. Upon completion of the qualification testing by the marines, the plan is to deploy these units in the field for powering environmental control units (ECU's). Although there is currently no firm commitment for additional orders, pending successful completion of qualification testing, the potential exists for a significant amount of units to be procured and deployed in the field in the future.

Dennis Sunshine, President and CEO of Orbit, commented, "Behlman's Commercial Division has once again capitalized on its ability to provide high quality cost effective commercial-off-the-shelf (COTS) solutions for military applications. Behlman's platform design concept enables its products to be easily configured to meet custom applications, thereby meeting the government's directive for using COTS solutions wherever possible."

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York, is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, uninterruptible power supplies and associated analytical equipment. The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for measurement and display.
