ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S BEHLMAN ELECTRONICS UNIT  
RECEIVES DEVELOPMENT ORDER FOR POWER SUPPLY TO  
BE USED ON UYQ-21 NAVAL DISPLAY CONSOLE

Order Expected To Lead To Annual Production Awards

Hauppauge, New York, April 22, 2003—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Unit Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc. (“Behlman”), has received an order from the U.S. Navy to develop a replacement commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) high voltage power supply used on the UYQ-21 Naval Display Console. The displays are used on Aircraft Carriers, Amphibious Assault Ships and Aegis Cruisers and Destroyers.

Dennis Sunshine, President and CEO of Orbit, commented, “The current supplier of these power supplies can no longer build or support their design so once again the Navy has turned to Behlman for its expertise in solving an obsolescence problem by providing its COTS power solutions.”

Mr. Sunshine added, “Although the initial order is for only seven units totaling \$84,000, the significance of this order is that based on yearly historical usage, we anticipate the U.S. Navy will require between 25 to 30 units on an annual basis resulting in approximately \$360,000 in additional business annually for Behlman.”

“In fact,” the CEO noted, “Behlman has received several new development orders in the last twelve months for its COTS power solutions that we are confident will ultimately result in significant yearly production orders. Furthermore, we remain confident that Behlman’s COTS power solutions will continue to generate new business opportunities in the military marketplace.”

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York, is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, uninterruptible power supplies and associated analytical equipment. The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for measurement and display.
