ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S POWER UNIT SEGMENT
RECEIVES \$260,000 IN NEW ORDERS FOR ITS COMMERCIAL
PRODUCTS FOR USE IN MILITARY PROGRAMS

Programs Could Lead to Significant Requirements in Future Periods

Hauppauge, New York, July 2, 2003, 2003—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Unit Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc., has received two new orders totaling approximately \$260,000 for its commercial division for use in military programs. Deliveries under these orders are expected to commence in this third quarter and continue into the first quarter of 2004.

Behlman received an order for \$165,000 for power supplies to be used on the test stations for the Global Hawk unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV). The Global Hawk is a UAV used by the United States military to perform aerial reconnaissance over extended periods of time for battlefield and homeland security programs. Behlman also received an order for its uninterruptible power supplies (UPS) to be used in a U.S. Army mobile satellite communications system. Although this initial order was for \$95,000, follow-on requirements are anticipated.

Dennis Sunshine, President and CEO of Orbit, commented, "We continue to see strong demand for customized versions of our commercial products that will be used in military programs. Both of these awards are initial orders for programs that could lead to significant follow-on requirements in coming years. We believe our commercial business in this market will continue to grow as the government looks for high quality-low cost solutions for its power requirements."

Orbit International Corp., based in Hauppauge, New York, is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, inverters, uninterruptible power supplies and associated analytical equipment. The Behlman custom division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for military and high-end industrial usage. For a more detailed discussion of the risks inherent in the Company's business the reader is referred to the Company's Annual Report on Form 10-KSB for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2002.
